Rules for Hunter Jumper Horse Show**

Judge: Ali Small Kovach

DIVISIONS:

Hunter Division: Height 18" to 24" (probably crossrails)

To be judged on the performance of the horse and form while executing the fences in the jumping classes and movement under saddle

1. Hunter Under Saddle – walk, trot, canter both ways of the arena
2. Hunter Over Fences – shown over a course of 8 to 10 fences
3. Hunter Over Fences – shown over a course of 8 to 10 fences

THIS DIVISION WILL BE AWARDED TO JUNIOR RIDERS AND ADULT RIDERS AS THEIR OWN INDIVIDUAL CLASSES AND DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS

Egg & Spoon Class

Leadline

Jumper Division: Height 2'3" to 2'6"

4. Power & Speed – a course of 8 jumps to be jumped with no faults then jumps 9 to 13 will be timed to determine placings.
5. Gambler's Choice – Riders have 90 sec to jump obstacles that vary in points from 10 to 100 according to difficulty. Riders will be credited for obstacles jumped with no faults. Obstacles may be jumped in any order and as much as twice. Start/finish line may be crossed in either direction.
6. Jumper Table 2a Class – first round to be jumped with no faults, then after all riders have gone, the riders whose horses had no faults will return to jump an altered jump off course to be timed with jumps to be raised to compete for first place.

THIS DIVISION IS AN OPEN DIVISION TO BE AWARDED ONE DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP

Pleasure Division: To be judged on the obedience and manageability of the horses or ponies entered

7. Pleasure - walk, trot, and canter both ways of the arena
8. Bridle Path Hack - walk, trot, canter both ways of the arena; possibly asked to hand gallop, halt and/or back up
9. Pleasure Hack – walk, trot, canter both ways of the arena; after the riders have performed all flat work, there will be 2 jumps no higher than cross rails of 18" to be executed

THIS DIVISION WILL BE AWARDED TO JUNIOR RIDERS AND ADULT RIDERS AS THEIR OWN INDIVIDUAL CLASSES AND DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS

Costume Class

Bareback Dollar

RULES:

1. Hard hats with chinstraps are required for riding over fences; otherwise protective head gear strongly recommended.
2. Boots with adequate heel required.
3. All riders are required to sign a liability waiver before they compete.
4. No martingales to be used in any under saddle or flat class.
5. Competitor number will follow horse and rider combination.
6. In case of bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to alter the course.
7. In all jumping classes, rider with three refusals will be eliminated from that class.
8. The organizers and property owners will not be responsible for loss or damage to persons or property.

DETAILS:

Location: Sidney Peak Ranch, 32130 Routt County Road 35, Steamboat Springs

Start Time: Classes Begin at 9 AM, Saturday, June 21: Schooling is from 8:00 to 8:45 AM

Entry Fees: \$10 per class per rider

Each participant must submit registration form, equine certificate of health form and activity release form prior to competing.

Participants are encouraged to wear horse show attire or colorful polo shirts.

Awards will be presented as close to the completion of each Division based on results from Division classes:

1st=5pnts, 2nd=3pnts, 3rd=2pnts, 4th=1pnt

In the event of a tie, the rider who scored the highest total points in over fences classes will determine the
Champion or Reserve Champion

White Saddle Pads to Champions, Colorful Schooling Pads to Reserve Champions + Ribbons through sixth place
