



## 2010 Cayuse Classic Rules for Outfitters Race

### RULES:

1. Each team will consist of two people
2. Each team member must be dressed in western clothing (including cowboy boots and hat) and wear leather gloves. Chaps are encouraged but not required
3. Community Agriculture Alliance will provide each team with the competition supplies including (but may not be limited to):  
One horse (which will be tame), pack saddle, bedroll, ground tarp, coffee pot, cooking pot, cooking grill, camp shovel, a bottle of whiskey and/or soft drink, set of panniers, manty cover
4. A maximum of four teams per round will be posted in the arena
5. One team member and the horse will be stationed at the starting line. The second team member will be at the opposite end of the arena lying inside a zipped bedroll. The camp gear for each team will be placed near the sleeping bag on the manty cover
6. At a gun-shot signal the horse will be led to the "camp-site" where the person in the sleeping bag must stay until the horse is within 10 feet of the camp. The horse is to be saddled, including correct application of the britching, breast collar and cinch. All camping gear must be securely packed into the pannier (be sure to take a good swig before packing the whiskey/soda), cover with the manty cover and buckle the top strap
7. When the horse is completely packed, both team members will lead the horse to the barrel, circle it counterclockwise and proceed to the finish line. First team that meets all of the criteria and crosses the line will win the round.
8. The winning team from each round will compete to determine the overall winner. If necessary a coin toss will be used to break tied times.
9. Clarification of Rules and Course will take place prior to the Race
10. All rules and requirements are subject to change

### CALCUTTA

1. Prior to the start of the first round, each team will be introduced to the crowd and auctioned in a Calcutta manner
2. Awards will be presented in the following manner:

Top Team	Bidder = 2 Cayuse Classic BBQ Tickets + 55% of bid Team Members = 2 Cayuse Classic BBQ Tickets + 30% of bid Community Ag Alliance = 15% of bid
Second Team	TO BE AWARDED ONLY IF FOUR OR MORE TEAMS ARE REGISTERED AND RECEIVE BIDS Bidder = 2 Cayuse Classic BBQ Tickets + 45% of bid Team Members = 2 Cayuse Classic BBQ Tickets + 25% of bid Community Ag Alliance = 30 % of bid
Other Teams	Community Ag Alliance = 100% of bid

Teams should be registered and ready to meet for instructions by 4:45 PM  
Start Time: 5:00 PM, Saturday, June 12, 2009  
Outfitters Race will be limited to twelve teams: First Registered = First Entered  
Entry Fees: Free to team members; all teams will be auctioned in a Calcutta manner  
Each participant must submit registration form and activity release form prior to competing.
