2010 Cayuse Classic Registration for Jackpot Roping

Classes: Handicap Draw Prize, Handicap #11

Registration will start at 9:30 AM at Martyn Meadows Ranch, 32320 RCR 20, Steamboat Springs

Trailer Parking is available east of the roping arena off of RCR 20. Follow signs.

Competition will start at 10:30 AM at Martyn Meadows and will conclude by 4 PM

Order of Competition will be: Handicap Draw Prize, Handicap #11

Entry Fees will be payable at the end of the Roping based on the number of the competitor's entries

Handicap Draw Prize: \$10 per person per entry

Handicap #11: \$20 per person per entry

Awards will be presented in each Class for the combination of fastest time of each class:

Handicap Prize: 1st place team = 4 Cayuse Classic BBQ Tickets + 2 Horse Blankets + 2 Tote Buckets
